Credit Card on File Policy

Beachside Pediatrics of Naples requires that a valid credit card be kept on file. Our credit card transaction company CardPointe stores encrypted information on a separate, secure site. Office staff will not have access to your card information, only the last 4 digits of your card will visible to staff.

The CardPointe Platform is a PCI-Certified Point-to-Point Encrypted (P2PE) solution. This level of data security is the same as ApplePay, Amazon, and other major retailers. P2PE eliminates 90% of the card data exposed by tokenizing every transaction as soon as it hits a card reader or hand-keyed online.

How our policy works

1. At the time of registration or checkout, you will be asked for your credit card information to be electronically stored in encrypted form in our computer. Only the last four digits are visible to our staff.
2. At checkout we will ask if you want to use the credit card on file for co-payments and/or unpaid balances. You may choose to present another card if preferred or any other form of payment.
3. We will submit your claim to your insurance company.
4. When we receive an explanation of benefits (EOB) from your insurance, we will send you a statement if any remaining balance is owed. If we have not received payment within 30 days, the credit card on file will be charged.
5. If we attempt to use your card and it is declined or has expired, we will send you a new statement with a note attached asking for current credit card information.
